

Iowa Renewable Fuels Infrastructure Program

The Iowa Department of Economic Development offers cost-share grants for the installation of E85 and biodiesel retail systems, biodiesel storage facilities, and tank wagons dedicated to renewable fuels.

Grants cover 50% of total expenses or a maximum of \$30,000 for:

- E85 dispensers
- Biodiesel dispensers
- Renewable fuels tank wagons

Grants cover 50% of total expenses or a maximum of \$50,000 for:

- Biodiesel storage facilities

Additional grants covering 75% of the cost to **upgrade** or **replace** E85 dispensers to comply with future Underwriter's Laboratory (UL) certification will also be available. Underwriter's Laboratory is in the process of accepting and certifying dispensers for E85 and it is anticipated that certified dispensers will be available in 2008. Iowa law requires that all E85 dispensers be UL certified by July 1, 2009.

Grant applications are reviewed quarterly by the Renewable Fuels Infrastructure Board. Deadlines for submitting applications are:

February 5, 2008

June 12, 2008

September 8, 2008

December 2, 2008
